# AFMC VOLUNTARY PROTECTION PROGRAM (VPP) STEERING COMMITTEE

#### **CHARTER**

#### I. INTRODUCTION:

The Air Force Materiel Command Voluntary Protection Program (VPP) Steering Committee (VPPSC) is formed at the direction of AFMC/CC. The Committee chair will report to AFMC/CC on the status of the cross functional implementation of VPP in AFMC.

## II. MISSION:

This charter defines the mission, membership, responsibilities, and administration of the AFMC VPPSC. The primary purpose of the VPPSC is to provide a forum for AFMC senior leaders to guide the cross functional implementation of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration VPP throughout the Command. Its aim is to create a culture where all employees share ownership in our safety and health management systems to drive a significant reduction in injury and illness rates. VPPSC meetings should also increase senior-level familiarity and raise awareness of VPP issues across AFMC.

## III. <u>RESPONSIBILITIES:</u>

- A. Provide a proactive link between AFMC programs and Headquarters Air Force (HAF) VPPSC strategies supporting the VPP Concept of Operations (CONOPS). The AFMC VPPSC will act as a check and balance to ensure AFMC efforts are in line with AF strategies. Additionally, the AFMC VPPSC will interface with the HAF VPPSC Working Group.
- B. Provide corporate support for AFMC cross functional policy and strategies affecting VPP.
- C. Provide a consensus position to the stakeholders who comprise the AFMC VPP community.
- D. Increase visibility of operational and strategic issues which affect the wellness and safety of the AFMC workforce.
- E. Provide oversight of issues identified by the HAF VPPSC and develop strategies for implementation and/or resolution.
- F. Provide policy and guidance to field organizations in respective functional areas to ensure consistency with VPP objectives and strategies.
- G. Identify and advocate for required resources to implement and maintain VPP and abate workplace hazards.

#### IV. MEMBERSHIP:

The VPPSC shall be chaired by the AFMC Executive Director (AFMC/CA) or designated representative, co-chaired by American Federation of Government Employees Council 214, and comprised of permanent members.

- AFMC/CA's designated VPPSC representative is HQ AFMC/A1
- Director or Deputy from HQ A staff and directorates, and AFMC Command Chief
- Senior Center Representative, e.g. Executive Director or ABW/CC and Union representation as desired
- President, AFGE Council 214
- Representative from International Association of Fire Fighters

### V. <u>ADMINISTRATION</u>:

HQ AFMC/SE will administer the meetings, to include scheduling meetings, distributing background materials, facilitating meetings, and publishing minutes to track action items.

The AFMC VPPSC will report to AFMC/CC annually on status of VPP implementation across the Command. All directorates/participants will ensure attendance at all VPPSC sessions. The VPPSC will meet at least semi-annually and prior to each HAF VPPSC. AFMC/CV represents AFMC on the HAF VPPSC. VPPSC participation cannot be delegated below the deputy director level without AFMC/CA approval.

This VPPSC Charter will be reviewed by VPPSC members annually and be maintained by AFMC/CA. The VPPSC Charter was coordinated with AFMC Directorates and Centers and will take effect upon the final approval of AFMC/CC.
